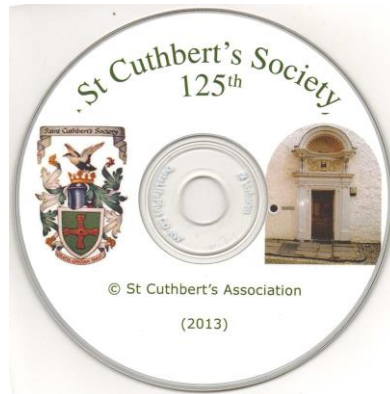




MEMORIES OF ST. CUTHBERT'S SOCIETY DURHAM UNIVERSITY
